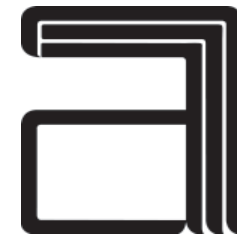

a nonprofit organization, was formed in 2000 by several working artists who were looking to make the arts a more visible part of the community. Since then the group has grown to over 100 members, who exhibit on a monthly or bimonthly basis at a variety of Arlington venues, including government offices, community organizations, churches, businesses, restaurants and cafes. The Alliance also hosts several annual exhibits, including a week long art festival at Fort C. F. Smith.

Through its monthly meetings, the Alliance offers a supportive and stimulating atmosphere to meet and network with other Arlington artists, as well as hosts presentations for professional development. The Alliance website lists local venues and offers individual profiles of members.

Since 2003, the Alliance has operated the Arlington Artists Academy with classes and workshops for both children and adults. The Alliance also sponsors the National Scholastics art competition for middle and high school students.

Alliance members work in a variety of styles and media, from representational to abstract, and include potters, wood workers and other 3-dimensional artists. The Alliance welcomes artists no matter where they are in their development, from student to emerging artist to working professional.
